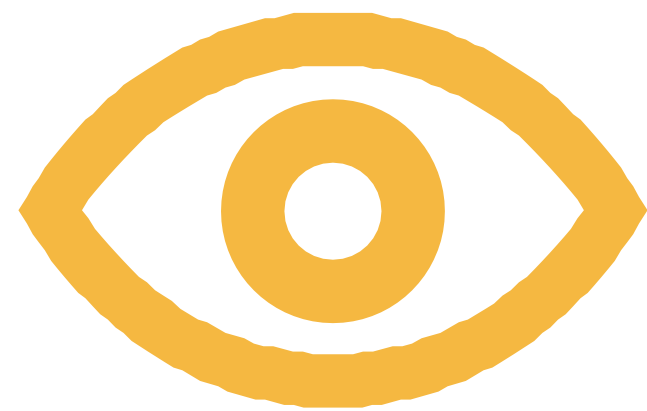

SDG 4 stands for inclusive, equitable and quality education as well as the opportunity to promote lifelong learning for all.

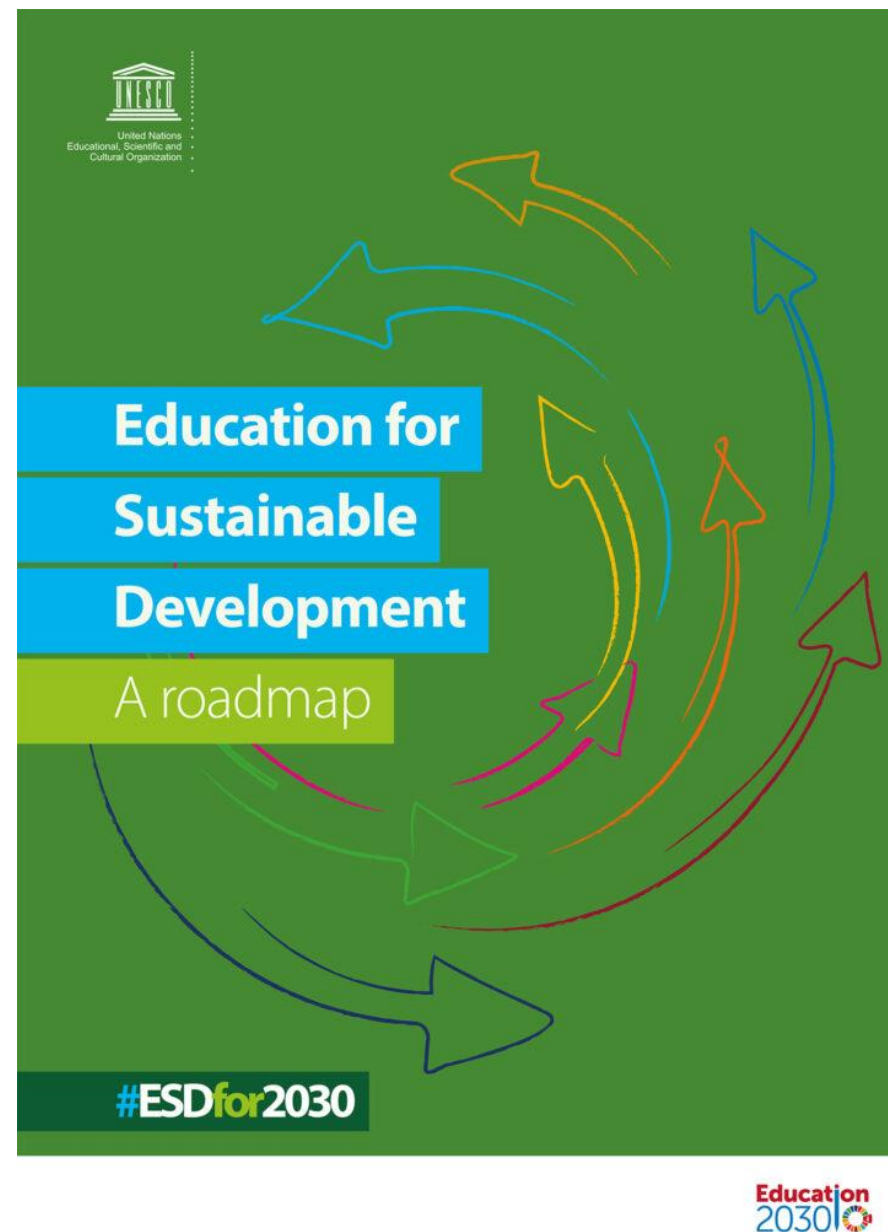

- **The Education 2030 Framework for Action**

Since 2005, UNESCO has consistently pursued the path of global dissemination and anchoring of education for sustainable development in society.

The implementation of the Education 2030 Framework for Action is closely linked to the implementation of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals of the United Nations.

In Austria, Forum Umweltbildung is the national focal point and network partner for the integration of Education for Sustainable Development into the Austrian educational landscape.

Education for Sustainable Development

What does that actually mean?

- **ESD provides knowledge in an action-oriented manner**

Guiding principle behind this is that everyone in the world can make a difference. Such thinking is important and necessary in order to initiate changes and tackle urgent global problems such as the overexploitation of nature or the unequal distribution of wealth.

- **ESD tries to equip people with shaping skills**

In order to understand the impact of their own actions on the world and to make sustainable decisions, people need competencies and skills.

- **ESD relies on a variety of methods in didactics**

ESD methods promote cooperative and research-led learning as well as the development of competencies such as systemic thinking, diversity of perspectives and creativity.

- **We mainly work with a train-the-trainer approach**

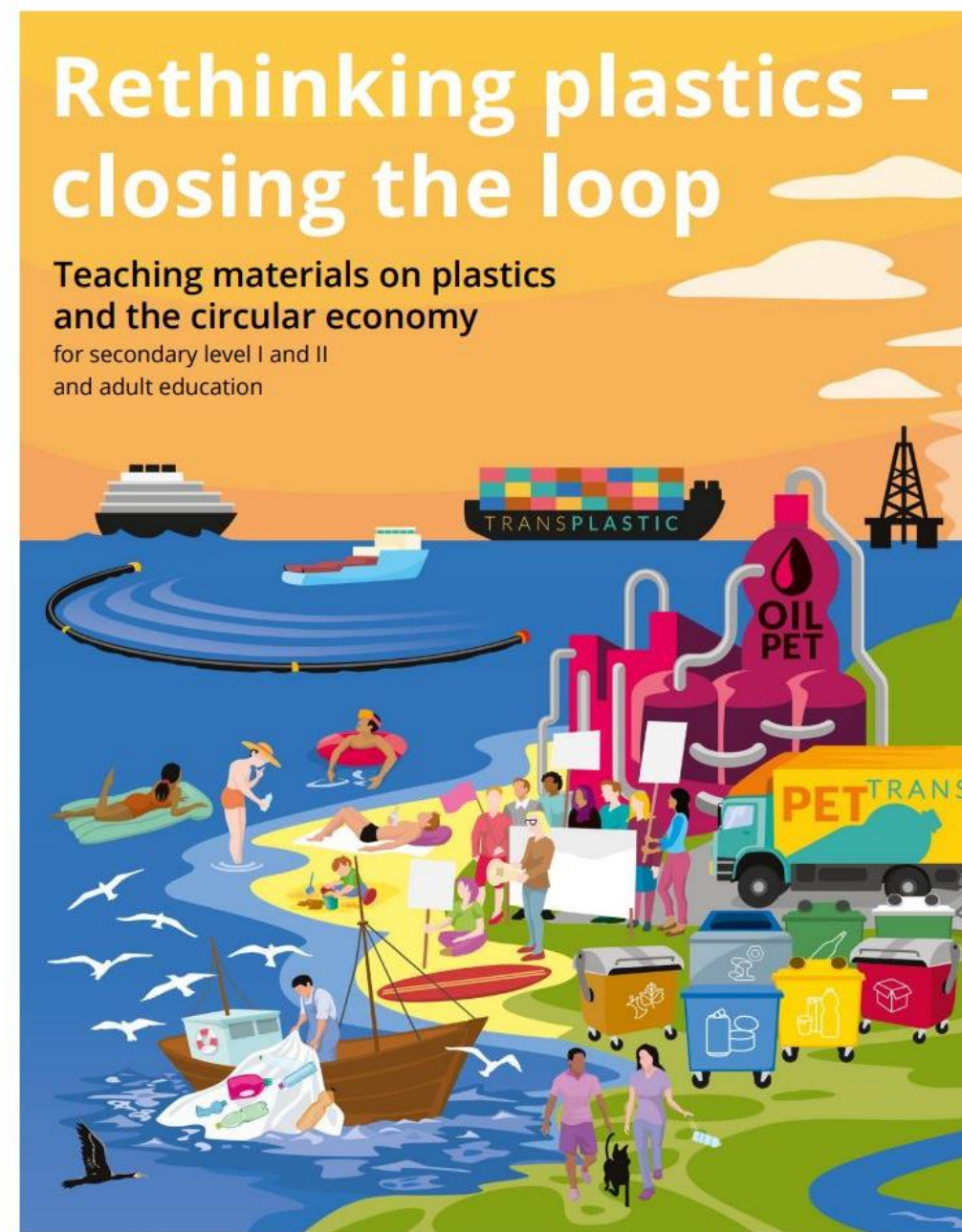

The [poster](#) enables young people aged 12 and over to reflect on the topics of plastic and the circular economy.

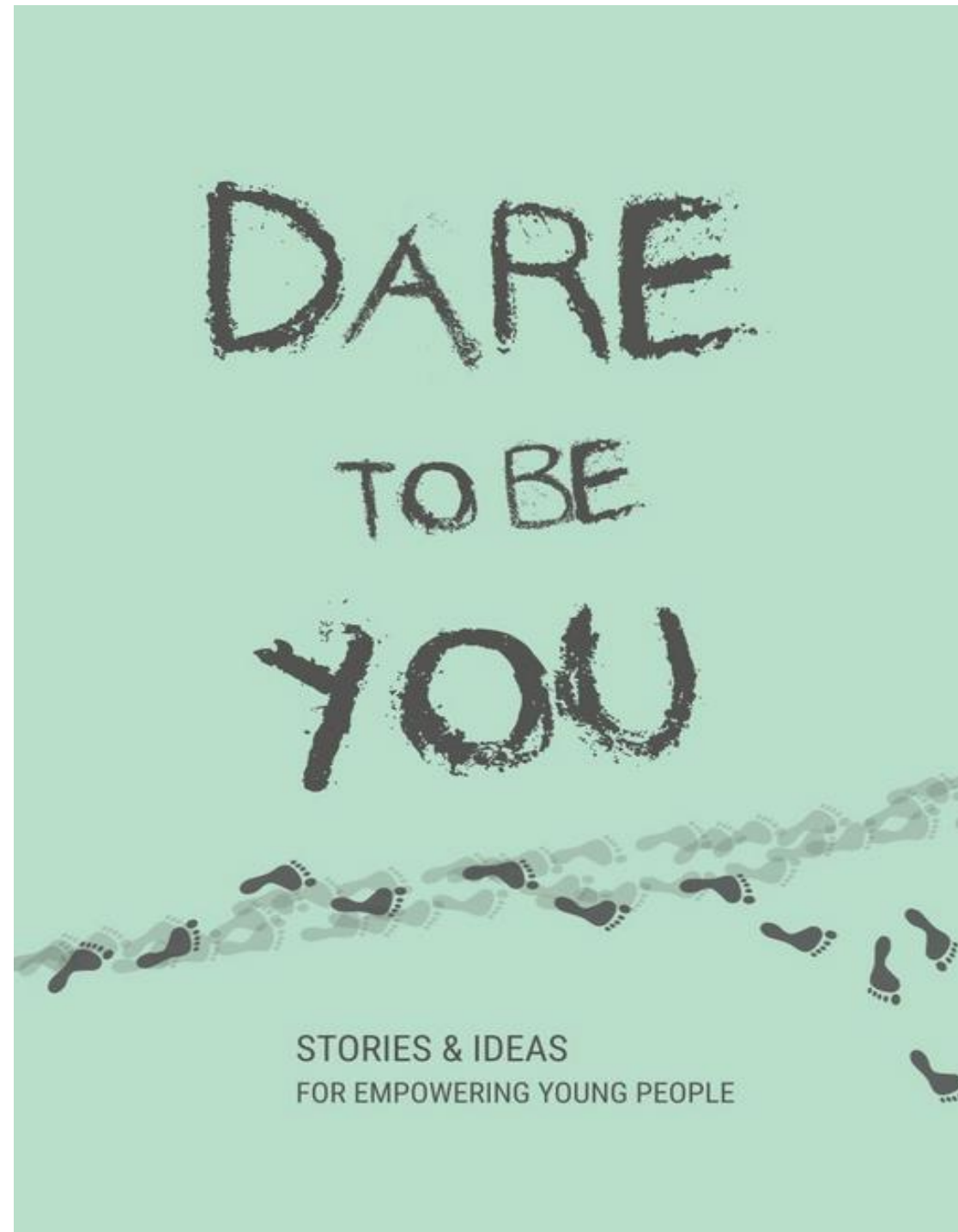
The poster is available in print (German) and for download online in several languages.

Einstieg

Zum Einstieg liest die Lehrperson die Geschichte „Ein Tag mit Miguel aus Kolumbien“ zu Ziel 4 vor. Im Plenum wird anschließend die Geschichte nachbesprochen:

- Warum besucht Miguel keine Schule?
- Warum möchte Miguel gerne eine Schule besuchen? Was ist sein Wunsch?
- Welche Fähigkeiten hat Miguel in seinem bisherigen Leben schon erlernt und wofür setzt er diese ein?
- Ist Lernen nur in der Schule möglich oder kann das auch an einem anderen Ort passieren?

[The BOX](#) contains innovative lesson plans to mix things up, which encourage learners to actively participate and think for themselves.

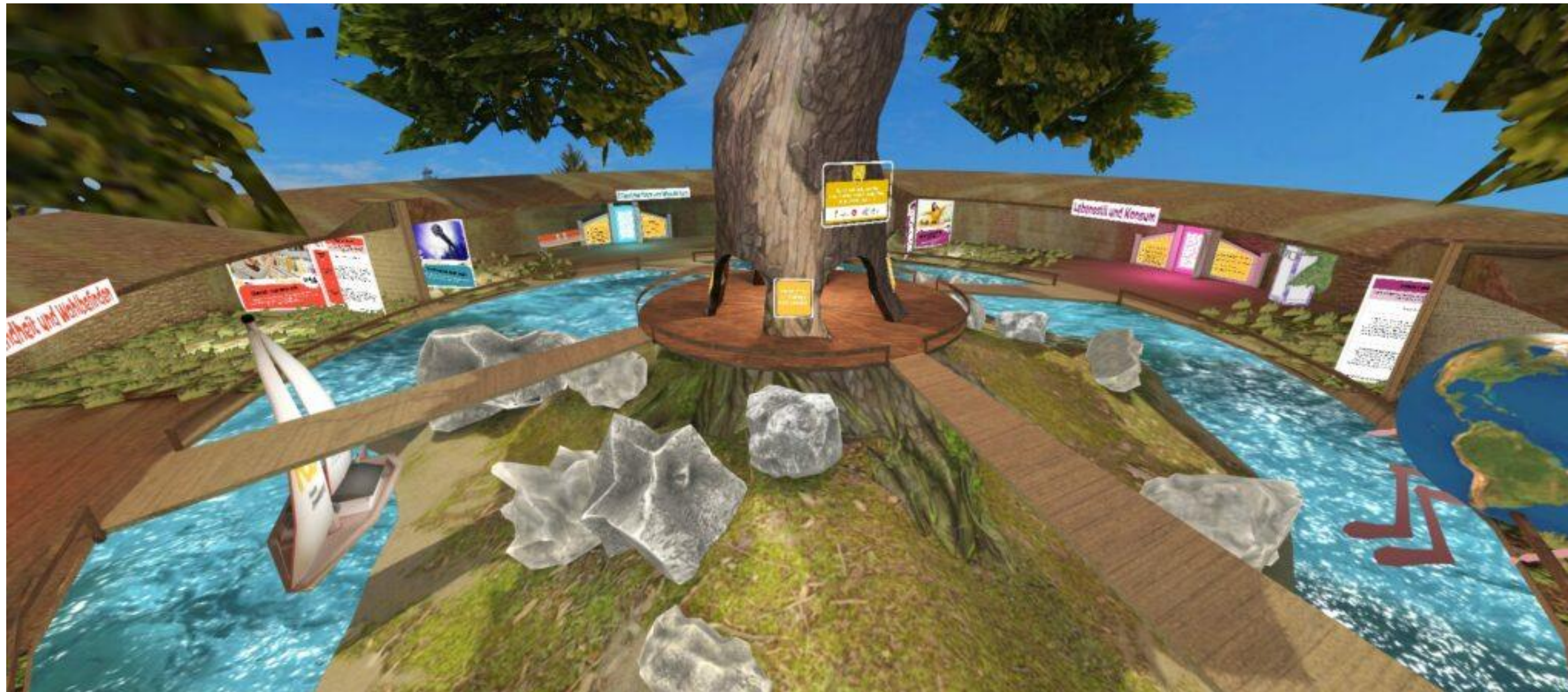
The implementation proposals contain a wide range of methods and are easy to carry out with little preparation time.
