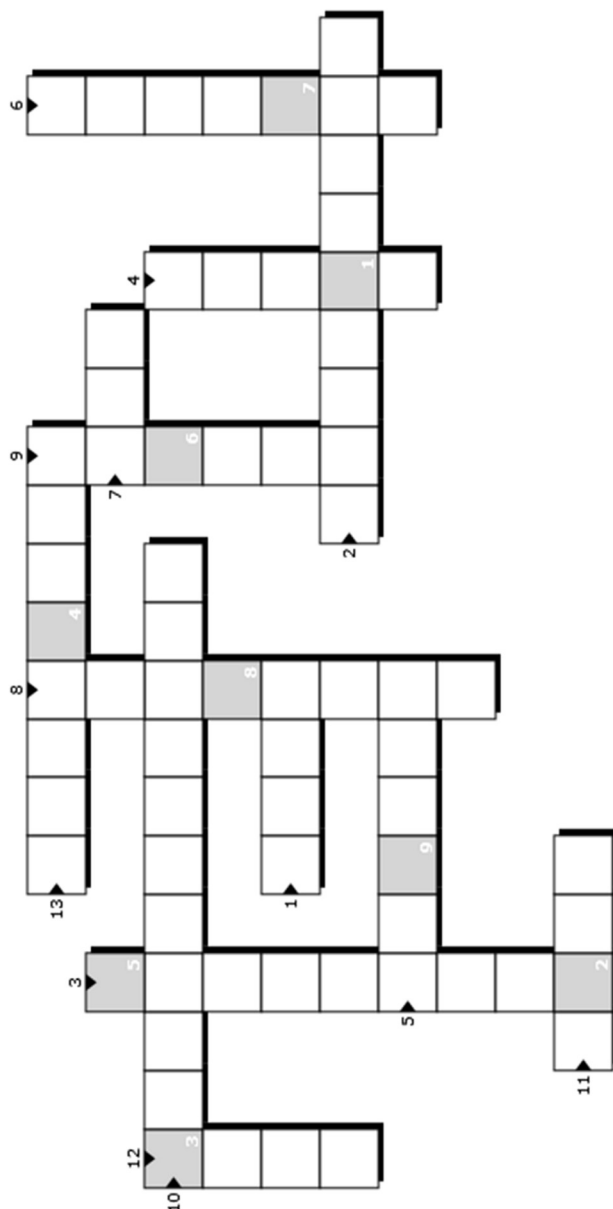


M1: Crossword

Put the grey letters into the correct order.

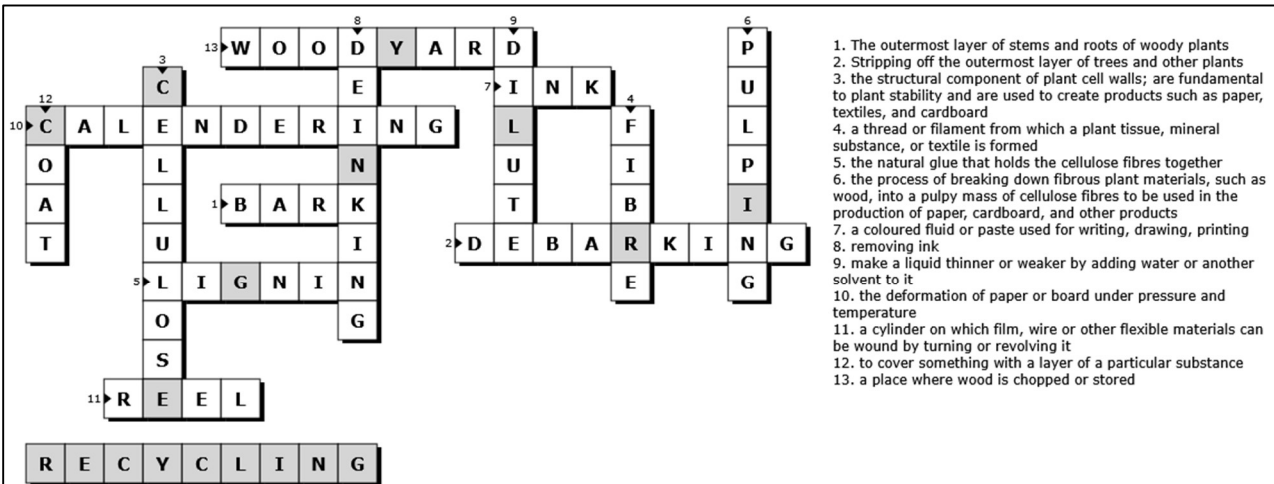
The solution describes a process that helps reduce the amount of wood in paper making. Have fun!

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1. The outermost layer of stems and roots of woody plants
2. Stripping off the outermost layer of trees and other plants
3. the structural component of plant cell walls; are fundamental to plant stability and are used to create products such as paper, textiles, and cardboard
4. a thread or filament from which a plant tissue, mineral substance, or textile is formed
5. the natural glue that holds the cellulose fibres together
6. the process of breaking down fibrous plant materials, such as wood, into a pulpy mass of cellulose fibres to be used in the production of paper, cardboard, and other products
7. a coloured fluid or paste used for writing, drawing, printing
8. removing ink
9. make a liquid thinner or weaker by adding water or another solvent to it
10. the deformation of paper or board under pressure and temperature
11. a cylinder on which film, wire or other flexible materials can be wound by turning or revolving it
12. to cover something with a layer of a particular substance
13. a place where wood is chopped or stored
